The FIREFOX was an educational art event carried out by several different people and organisations in Utsjoki. It consisted of science and art events, of which the common theme was the Northern lights and their research. The main goal of the project was to educate and to produce events that would touch and unite all of the villagers, from the Finnish to the Sámi and from the children to the elderly. Other goals included increasing knowledge and know-how regarding winter art, developing ways in which science and art could support each other.

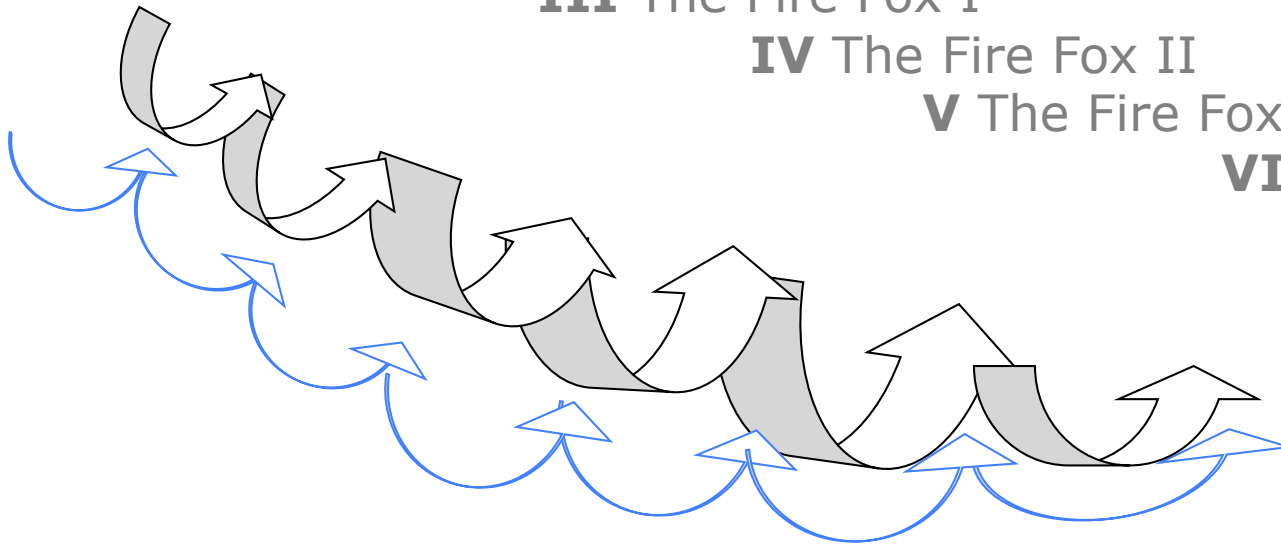

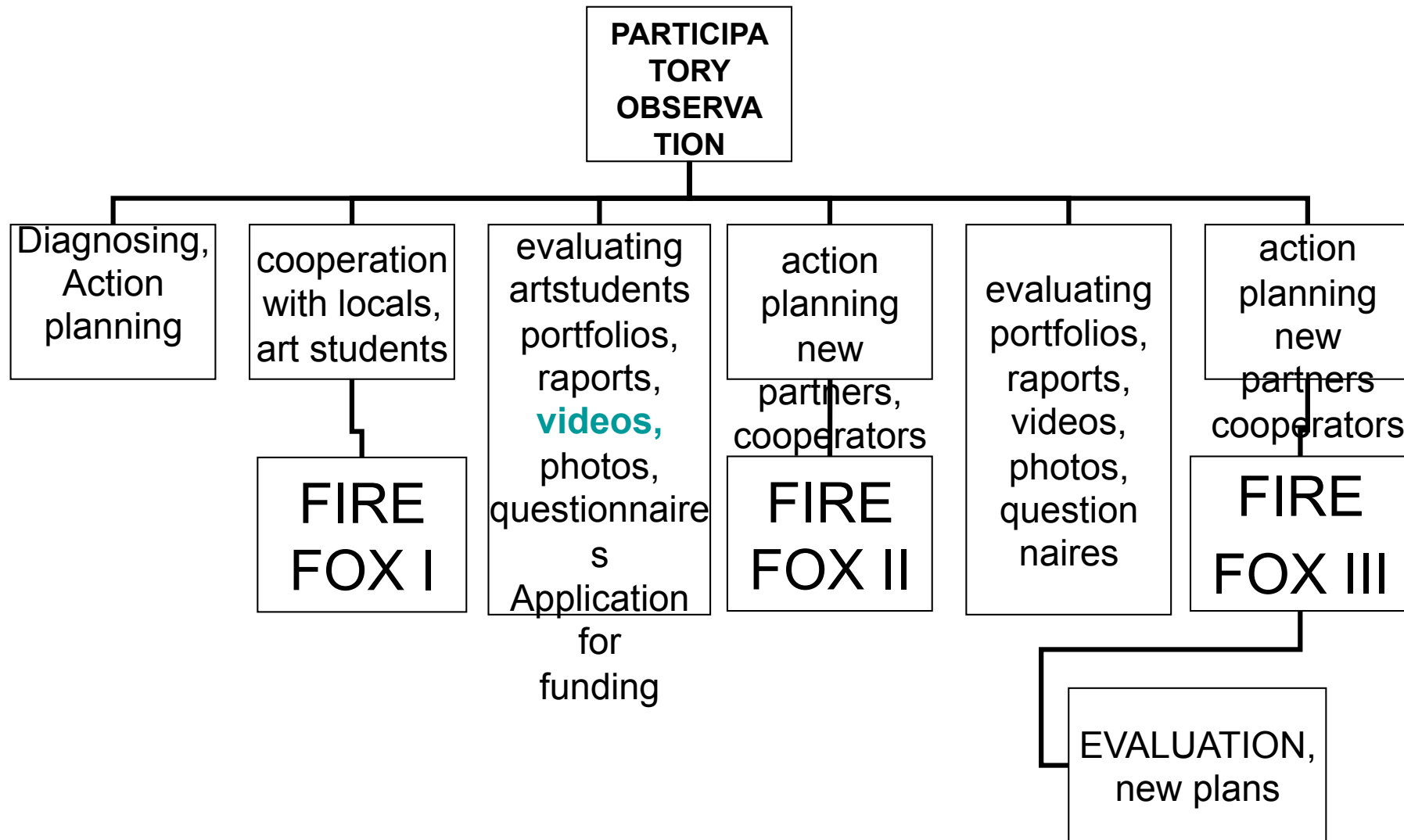
